Tour

A new 77,000-square-foot distribution center was built to house the new Koenig & Bauer AG Colora Berliner press. The press weighs 1.2 million pounds, is 56 feet high, and has a capacity of 75,000 papers per hour. The paper runs through the press at a speed of about 20 mph. A special heating and cooling system was installed to ensure constant temperature and humidity. Variations in temperature or humidity can affect how the paper runs through the press and the drying time of the ink.

Dinner will follow the tour at the Peanut Bar at approximately 7:30 P.M. ASQ members may park in the back of the Peanut Bar. Simply tell the guard you are with the ASQ group. People wishing to park on the street, there is no charge in the parking meters after 6:00 P.M.
