Presentation: Tour of [Kalas Wire](#)

Directions to Kalas Wire

From Reading, take Route 222 South towards Lancaster. Take the exit for the PA Turnpike and Route 272. Turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp. Continue to the intersection and turn left at the traffic light onto Route 272 South. At the next light make a right turn. Stay on this road for about 3 miles. This road becomes Main Street in Denver. Kalas's main plant is on the right next to Denver Supply. Denver Beer Distributors is on the left. Park in the large parking lot across the street from Kalas. Cross the street and enter Kalas at the main lobby.

The tour will start promptly at 6:00 P.M. There will be a short introduction and presentation and then we will tour Plant #1. This should last about 45 minutes. We will then drive down the road and tour Plant #2 which will take another 45 minutes.

We will then drive back to Denver and eat at the Foxchase Golf Club at approximately 7:30 P.M.

NOTE: Safety shoes are not required, but please bring safety glasses if you have them. If not, glasses will be provided.

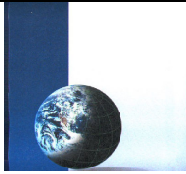
