Drive about 2 miles and make a left onto DORMA Drive just after you pass in front of the brick Reamstown Mennonite School (on left). Proceed up DORMA Drive and turn right at our building. The entrance gate and parking area can be seen from there. We will have signs to show you where to enter the building.

From Lancaster:

Drive north on Route 222 towards Reading. Take the right Denver exit. At the traffic light turn left. Proceed approximately ½ mile. About 50 yards before the next traffic light, make a left onto Reamstown road. Drive about 2 miles and make a left onto DORMA Drive just after you pass in front of the brick Reamstown Mennonite School (on left). Proceed up DORMA Drive and turn right at our building.
