Presentation

Using ISO 9001 to Support SOX Implementation

Quality Managers with a robust quality management system can support their financial and accounting functions efforts to meet Sarbanes-Oxley (SOX) by training these functions in the basic ISO 9001 system.

ISO 9001 systems provide evidence, via procedures, methods, audits, and records, that actions and reviews are conducted according to plan. These systems also help identify and

manage risks that can negatively affect financial position and related financial reports. The data required to maintain registration to ISO 9001 offers valuable evidence in support of SOX compliance, but only if Quality Managers and others in management realize the connection.
